Bill Dewick and I have continued to do Speedwatch over the past year, this has sometimes been difficult due to bad weather and ill health. However, we persevered and have done this whenever we could. More volunteers would be very welcome.

The reporting system has become much more efficient and I completed a Zoom meeting to learn the new system and also meet some volunteers from other villages.

I have also been in touch with Martin Kinsey at Wattisham Airfield in the hope that we could replicate a system being employed by a private person in Ringshall in co-operation with Wattisham – to report speeding Army personnel to Mr Kinsey. However, having contacted the Community Speedwatch Team, we have been informed we cannot use our equipment for this purpose as we 'work' for this team and it would breach Date Protection.

SID – the Speed Indicator Device has been used in three places this year and we would like to thank Arland Shaw -Taylor for being prepared to move the device at regular intervals. The data collected from this machine is stored in the hope that it will prove useful in the future.

I think a campaign to try and recruit some more volunteers would be a good idea, as we do have the appropriate equipment, this would have to be in co-ordination with the CSW as volunteers have to be police approved.
